Orthopaedic Elective Experience

My elective orthopaedic practice is based at The Royal Bournemouth Hospital. My sub specialist interest is in complex foot & ankle conditions, which makes up the majority of my elective practice. I host visiting surgeons wishing to learn the latest techniques in foot and ankle surgery and see patients referred for a second opinion from around the central south coast region. I have also recently been elected as President of the British Orthopaedic Foot & Ankle Society.

Orthopaedic Trauma Experience

My trauma practice is based at Poole Hospital. I am on call regularly for this large trauma unit and accept patients admitted with the full range of injuries. I see patients presenting with a wide range of traumatic conditions, including multiply injured patients, upper and lower limb injuries and patients with spinal injuries. I also have a particular interest in complex injuries of the foot and ankle and have published and presented extensively on the subject.

Teaching & Training

I maintain an active role in teaching the next generation of orthopaedic surgeons. I have been the local Specialist Training Committee representative for Wessex and have previously been voted as the Wessex Region Trainer of the Year, a highly prestigious post, voted for by the orthopaedic trainees in the Wessex region. I lecture on a number of national courses, including the prestigious Royal National Orthopaedic Hospital Foot & Ankle Course and have been a member of the BOFAS Educational Committee. I have been invited to lecture at a number of national & international conferences, including The BOA, BOFAS & AOFAS.

Medico Legal Experience

I have extensive medico-legal experience. I have had an active medico-legal practice for over 15 years and see a mixture of personal injury and clinical negligence cases. My clinical negligence practice is concentrated on cases that involve the management of foot and ankle conditions, in particular relating to patients that present with complications after foot and ankle surgery.

Positions of Responsibility

I have been a member of council for The British Orthopaedic Foot & Ankle Society for seven years and in November 2019, was elected as President of the society. I advise on issues of national policy that relate to foot and ankle conditions and also sit on the Scientific, Educational & Outcome Committees. In 2021, I began my term as President of BOFAS, culminating in the annual scientific meeting that I hosted at The BIC, Bournemouth, in March 2022.

I am the Clinical Governance and Risk lead for Orthopaedics at University Hospitals, Dorset and advise the trust on issues of consent, with particular emphasis on the Montgomery case and the implications of this.

Research & Publications

I maintain a very active interest in research and regularly publish work in international peer reviewed journals, as well as presenting at regional, national & international meetings. Recent topics of research have included crush injuries of the foot, ankle replacement, tumours of the foot & ankle, surgery for achilles tendon injuries, complex hind foot deformity, ankle fractures, achilles tendonitis, advances in bunion surgery and trauma in elderly patients.
